The Optimist Club of Birmingham was honored to have **Tanita Cain, District Court Judge for Jefferson County 10th Judicial District, Place 6**, as our distinguished guest speaker. She was appointed Special District Court Judge and has been a member of the Jefferson County Executive Committee of the Democratic Party. She has more than 25 years of legal experience.

Judge Cain's primary focus was on her work with domestic violence offenders and victims. She also spoke of how domestic violence affects a large number of youth in our community, as well as about the programs she has been implementing, since taking the bench in January of this year, to help stop the cycle of abuse and recidivism.

Judge Cain is extremely involved in the community and is a member of several legal and community organizations. She has received a ton of awards for her social activism in the community. She created a Lawyers and Judges for Literacy Program where the area judges and lawyers pitch in to combat illiteracy.

Before becoming a Judge, she was the founder of The Cain Law Firm, LLC, a general practice firm which specializes in criminal law. As an attorney, she has received many professional acknowledgments. She has also provided numerous hours of pro bono legal services which included, but not limited to, closing her firm for two weeks to work with victims in devastated areas, providing free wills for the elderly, and helping people expunge criminal charges.


READ ACROSS AMERICA

Interesting note: Erma shared that Adrienne was one of her best friends in high school and they studied theater together at West End High! "Reading was fun today!" *E*


