He shared pictures and information on the progress that has been made since his last visit, on the library and other projects taking place there. Thank you to Dr. Amamoo and his daughter, Anihee Amamoo, for sharing the following information:

Cultivating Partnerships in Ghana (CPG), is a non-profit organization that was established to create educational, economic, and cultural understanding, in addition to cultivating opportunities between the citizens of both Ghana and Birmingham, AL.

The members of CPG have been travelling to serve the people of Ghana for well over 40 years and have observed many unmet needs of the people in Ghana. As a result, CPG has established several projects to assist the natives of Ghana. Projects have included building a library and community center in Apaaso, Ghana, developing educational exchange opportunities between students from Alabama and Winneba, Ghana, Brown Babies and Cars drive for an orphanage in Winneba, and building four wells in the Volta region of Ghana to assist with providing clean water to these communities.

Their most recent project embarks on an essential mission to improve the learning environment for students in the Christ Shalom Preparatory School in Hohoe, Ghana, who have an enormous need for functional desks and chairs at school. As we all know, quality education requires an environment that is conducive to learning, and one of the fundamental elements of such an environment is having adequate and suitable furniture. Through the support of some they were able to donate 17 desks to the school. Through further support they aim to address this pressing issue and ensure the students have the resources necessary to thrive academically.
