MAY 19TH CLUB MEETING

The Optimist Club of Birmingham was honored to have Club Member, the **Honorable Patricia Stephens**, Presiding Circuit Judge for the Domestic Relations Division, Jefferson County, as our speaker at the May 19th meeting. Her presentation focused on foster parenting, which she believes aligns with Optimist International's mission of bringing out the best in youth.

Judge Stephens reported that there are currently approximately 6,000 children, up to the age of 18, in foster care in our state, which doesn't include those who should be in foster care due to situations that are no fault of their own. Foster parenting is an incredibly vital need, providing children who have experienced trauma or instability with a safe, nurturing environment and a chance to thrive. Whether it be through serving as a foster parent, being a respite provider to give foster parents a much-needed break, or providing other types of support, even if you can only help just one child, that's one for whom you made a difference in their life.
